Subsidized Employment Program

Employers Needed

Employers are needed to put local residents back to work. Federal stimulus money (American Recovery & Reinvestment Act) will soon arrive in this county.

Employers are needed to provide approximately 30 hours a week of employment & training for approximately 6 months. Employers provide the work and the County – using federal stimulus money – provides the wages and worker's compensation insurance. The goal of the stimulus money is to provide recent work experience so local residents are more competitive in job market.

How Does it Work?

The County – through its Workforce Services Bureau – refers eligible residents to interested employers. The employer selects from among those referred and provides supervised work experience. The County is the employer of record and sets the pay and then pays the wages and insurance.

What Types of Jobs?

Entry level jobs in every imaginable field – what do you need? What you can't do is use these stimulus jobs to replace employees you had to let go because of the economic downturn – they need to be different, and they need to be entry level.
